"FLEEING THE NAZI INFERNO. WHY CHILE?"**

Eva Wyman and her family fled Nazi Germany for Chile, where she grew up before marrying Mark Wyman and moving to Illinois. Her talk will be from her book, published in November, 2008: "Fleeing the Nazi Inferno: The German Jewish Migration to Chile in the 1930's." It is based on interviews with 35 German Jews who fled Nazi Germany to Chile, their stories from Germany and from Chile. It also utilizes stories from newspapers, books and from the Chilean Archives.

She describes her talk as being stories about both bad and "good" Nazis, the difficulty of finding a country to immigrate to, with stories of my interviewees in Chile and my own story.

Why did Jews choose to go to Latin America and why to Chile? Chile's newly elected president opened the door to Jewish immigration. The large German Aryan immigration into Chile from the 1850s on provided a base from which the Nazis grew. Chile's own Naci (written with "c") party spoke against Hitler's anti-Semitism."
